

stained glass window art



you will need:

- a plastic lid (sour cream, yogurt, etc)
- clear or white glue
- food colouring or sparkle glue/glow-in-the-dark glue
- toothpicks
- hole punch or needle
- string

Step 1- Fill a lid with either white glue or clear glue, make sure it covers the whole surface.

Step 2- Add drops of food colouring or coloured glue and swirl the colours around with a toothpick, don't mix too much or the colours will get muddy.

Step 3- Let dry 2-3 days depending on how much glue you used. If you leave your lid in the sun it will dry faster.

Step 4- When dry gently peel the glue off the lid, punch a hole in the top, add string and it can be hung in a window.

I made two, one with food colouring and one with glow-in-the-dark/sparkle glue.
